INFORMATION ABOUT THE CONTEST	An International contest of children creativity “Children all over the world are friends” was established in 2006. In 2017 the contest will be held for the 6 th time. In the previous years children from 39 states such as: Armenia, Azerbaijan, Bangladesh, Belarus, Bulgaria, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Hungary, Germany, Georgia, India, Indonesia, Iran, Qatar, Canada, Kazakhstan, China, Kyrgyzstan, Laos, Latvia, Lithuania, Moldova, the United Arab Emirates, Poland, Russia, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Syria, Serbia, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Turkey, Uzbekistan, the Ukraine, the Philippines, Croatia, Sri Lanka, Ecuador, Estonia took part in this contest. More than 44000 illustrations of creative works, which got us acquainted with the young artists, their lives, their friends, relatives, their hobbies and dreams. And we also have learnt about different nations as well as with their history, culture, nature and people.

THE TERMS OF THE CONTEST	Children from 4 till 16 are able to take part in this contest. The works can be provided by an educational institution, public organization or private individuals. The individuals can send not more than 2 works. Each institution can send not more than 15 works. The works are accepted only in originals. Copies, photo-copies, scans, digital versions are not going to be accepted and judged. The works, which fail to meet with the following terms and conditions are going to be disqualified. The works sent to the contest are not going to be returned. The organizer becomes the owner of the works, which were sent for the contest. Your application means that you agree with the mentioned terms and conditions. The organizer reserves the right to publish and exhibit the works.

THE REQUIREMENTS TO THE WORKS AND TO THEIR DESIGN

The pictorial and graphic works, which are performed in various techniques, are accepted. The works should be provided without any design. The works shouldn't be folded up or rolled

The minimal size of the work is 30 x 40 cm and the maximum size is 50 x70 cm. An application form should be filled out in block letters in Russian or English language and should be attached to each work.

From each educational institution (author) the joint application form should be filled out, and should include: the titles of all works, full address and contact information of the institution (artist), teacher. All the works will be assessed by a professional jury, which consists of the leading teachers of visual arts, artists, art historians and the workers of art galleries.

**SIZING UP AND
THE AWARDING
SYSTEM OF THE
CONTEST**

All works of the contestants will be divided into 4 age groups:

- From 4 till 6
- From 7 till 9
- From 10 till 13
- From 14 till 16

And into 2 nominations:

- Painting
- Graphics

The jury reserves the right to determine the number of winners in each nomination (the number of prizewinners can be increased or vice versa).

The winners and the prizewinners are going to be awarded with medals and the certificates of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd degree by Ministry of Education of the Republic of Belarus as well as with the catalogues of the contest.

The additional nomination will be presented “The Prize of the jury for the best international collection from a foreign artistic studio”, “The Prize of the jury for the best collection from a Belarusian artistic studio”

The exhibition that is going to be formed out of the best works, which were received till 30 December 2017, will be held in March 2018 in the exhibition hall of the National center of artistic creativity of children and youth in Minsk.

Authors of best works will be granted with a certificate of a contestant (1000 certificates) and all educational institutions will receive the letter of gratitude.
